1. OLD Business - SEAC Recommendations made to Superintendent Alexander:

A. more frequent meetings with varying times so that parents have different opportunities to attend **APPROVED:** Increase to Bi-monthly meetings with alternating times: February, April, June, August, October, December; meetings will rotate between NOON and 6pm - NEXT meeting April

- B. **APPROVED**: a one page informational sheet that explains the IEP process and encourages & welcomes parents as critical team members
- C. **APPROVED**: Welcome Packet that provides parents with IEP information and resources in a user-friendly format
- D. **APPROVED**: Increased number of SEAC council members: starting with 2022-2023 school year, SEAC team will double in size from four members to eight members. Members will be selected this Spring (April release of member application). SEAC will comprised of 50% parents, 25% district special education staff, and 25% other stakeholder.
